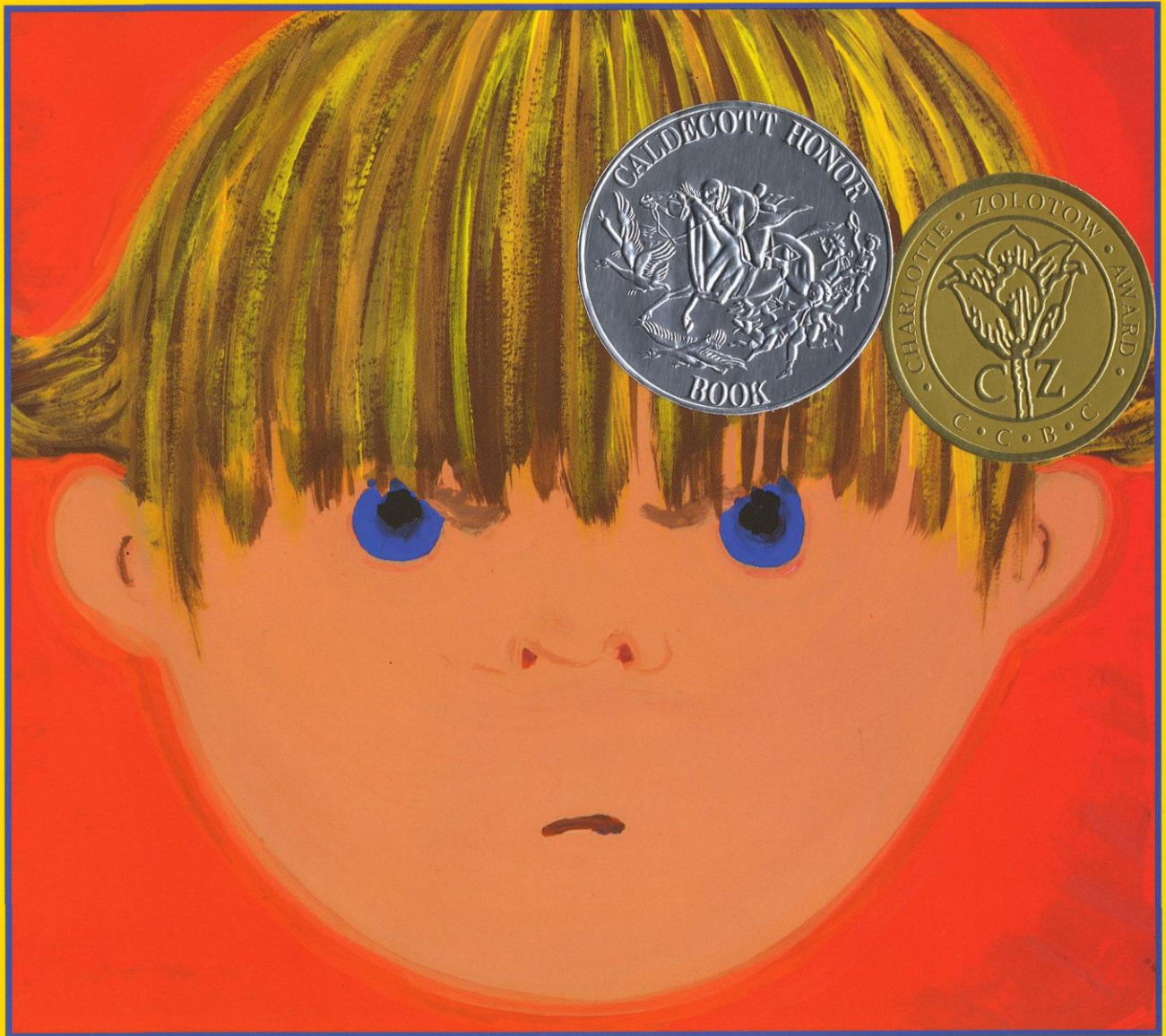

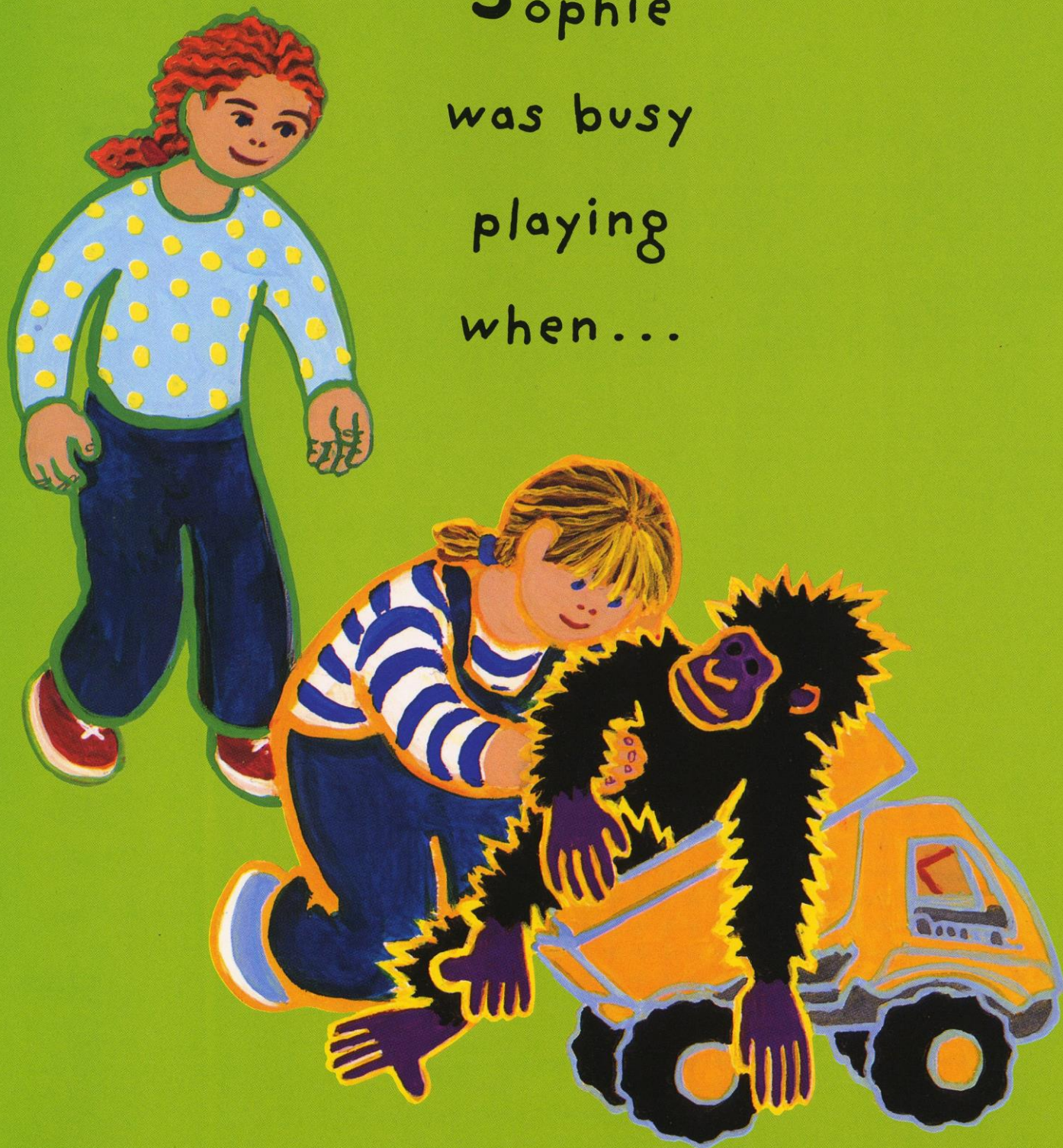

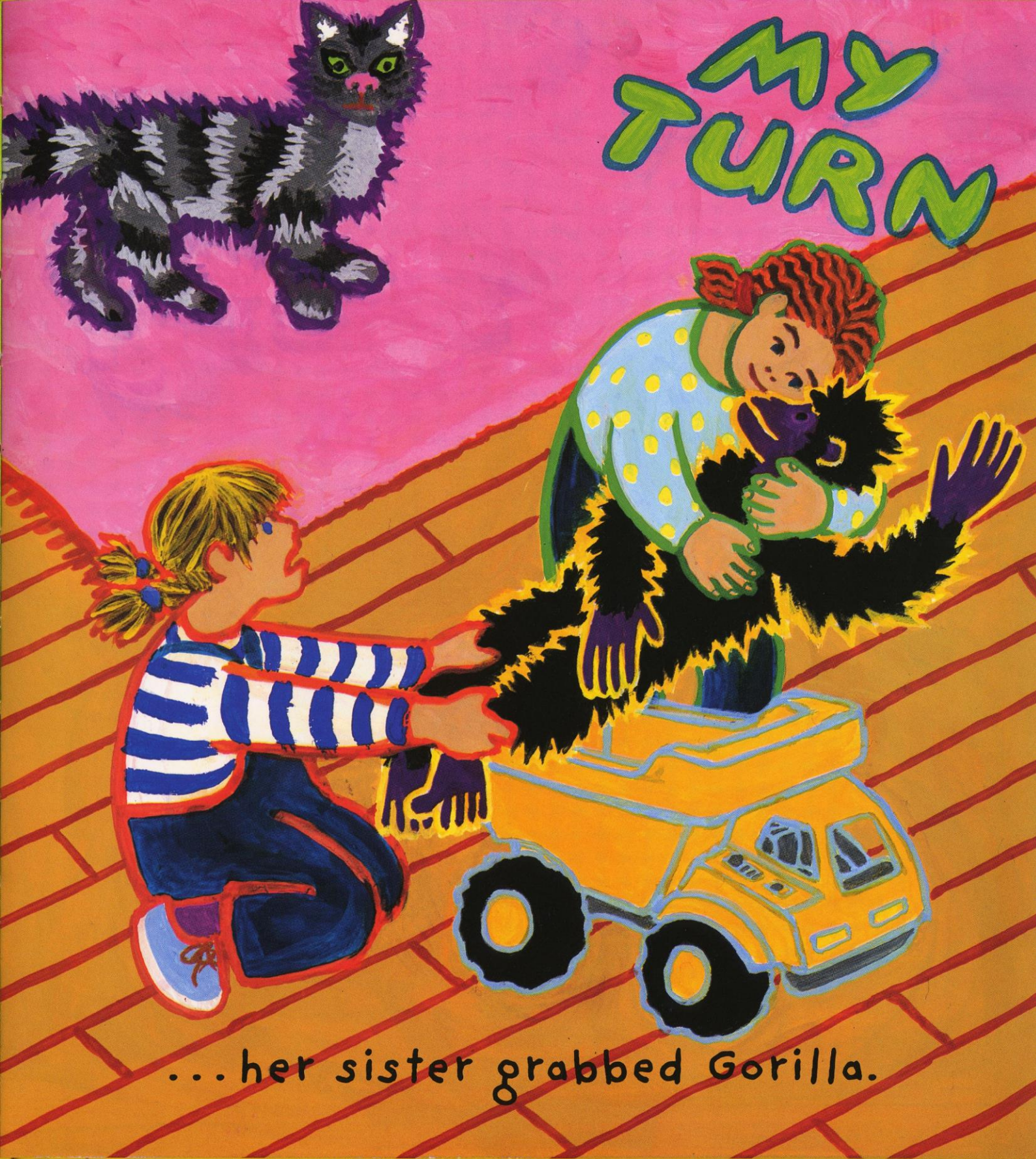

...her sister grabbed Gorilla.

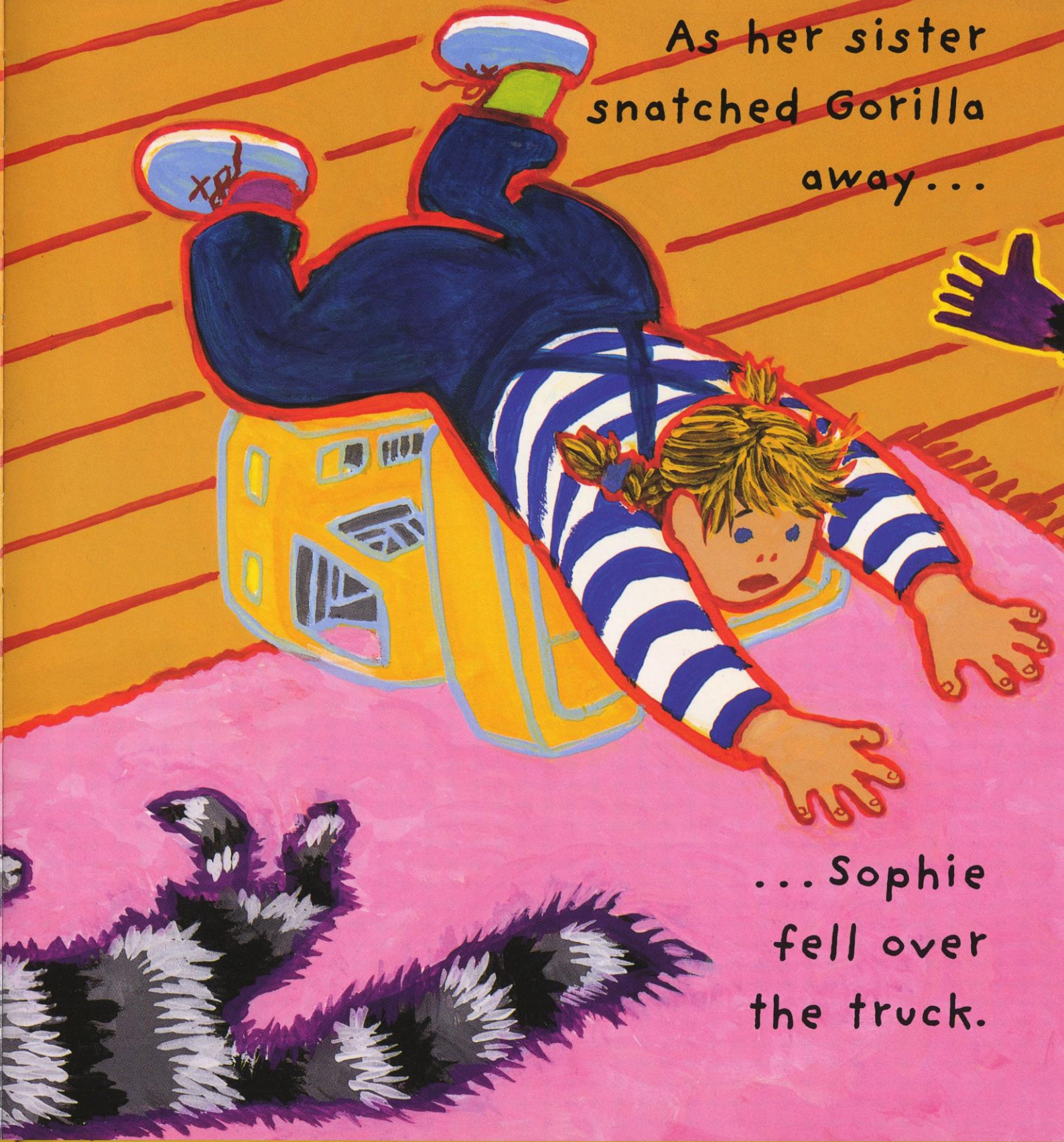


"No!" said Sophie.

now!



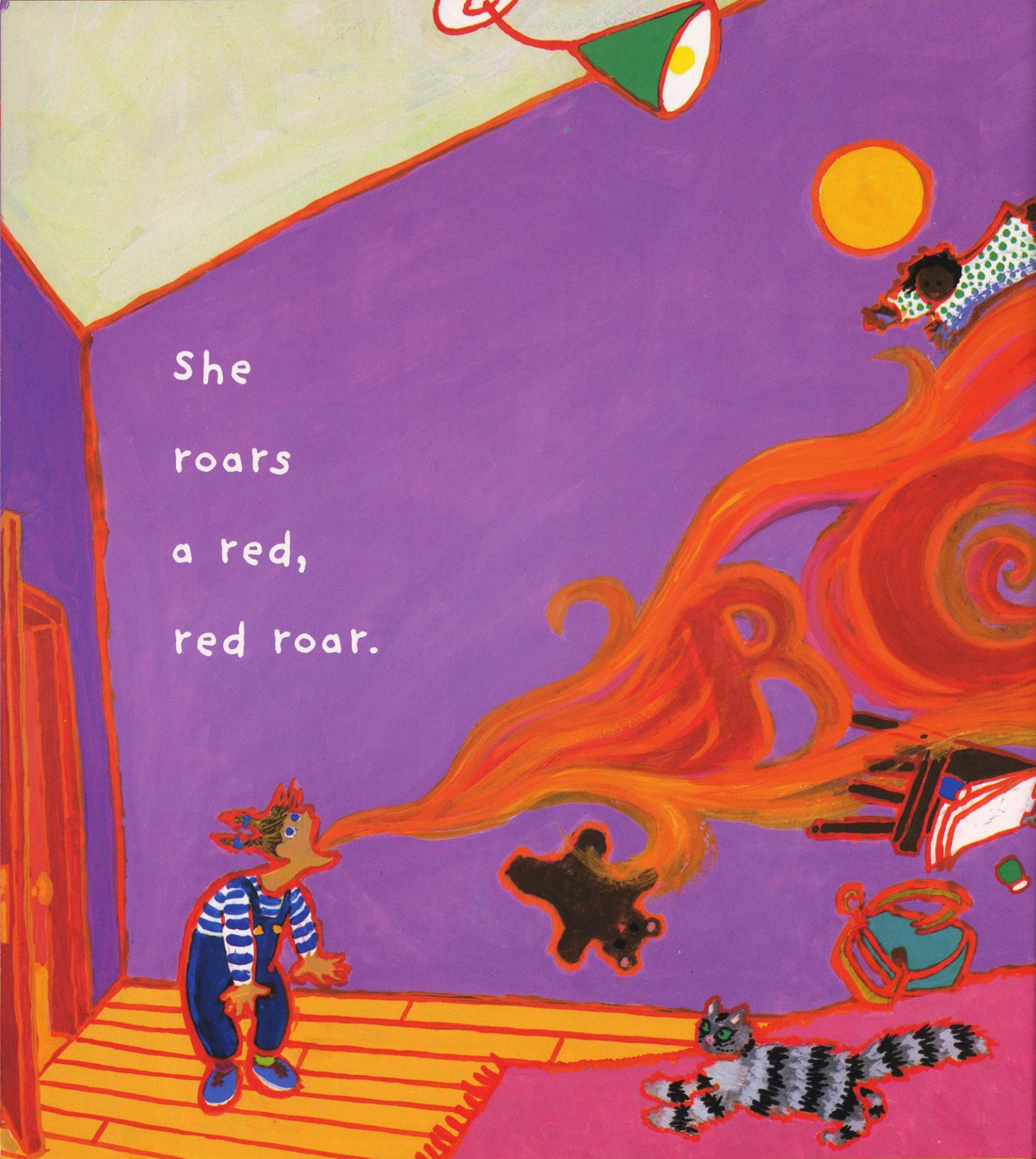




She kicks. She screams.

world to smithereens.





can't run anymore.






Then,

she cries.






Now she sees the rocks,

She climbs.



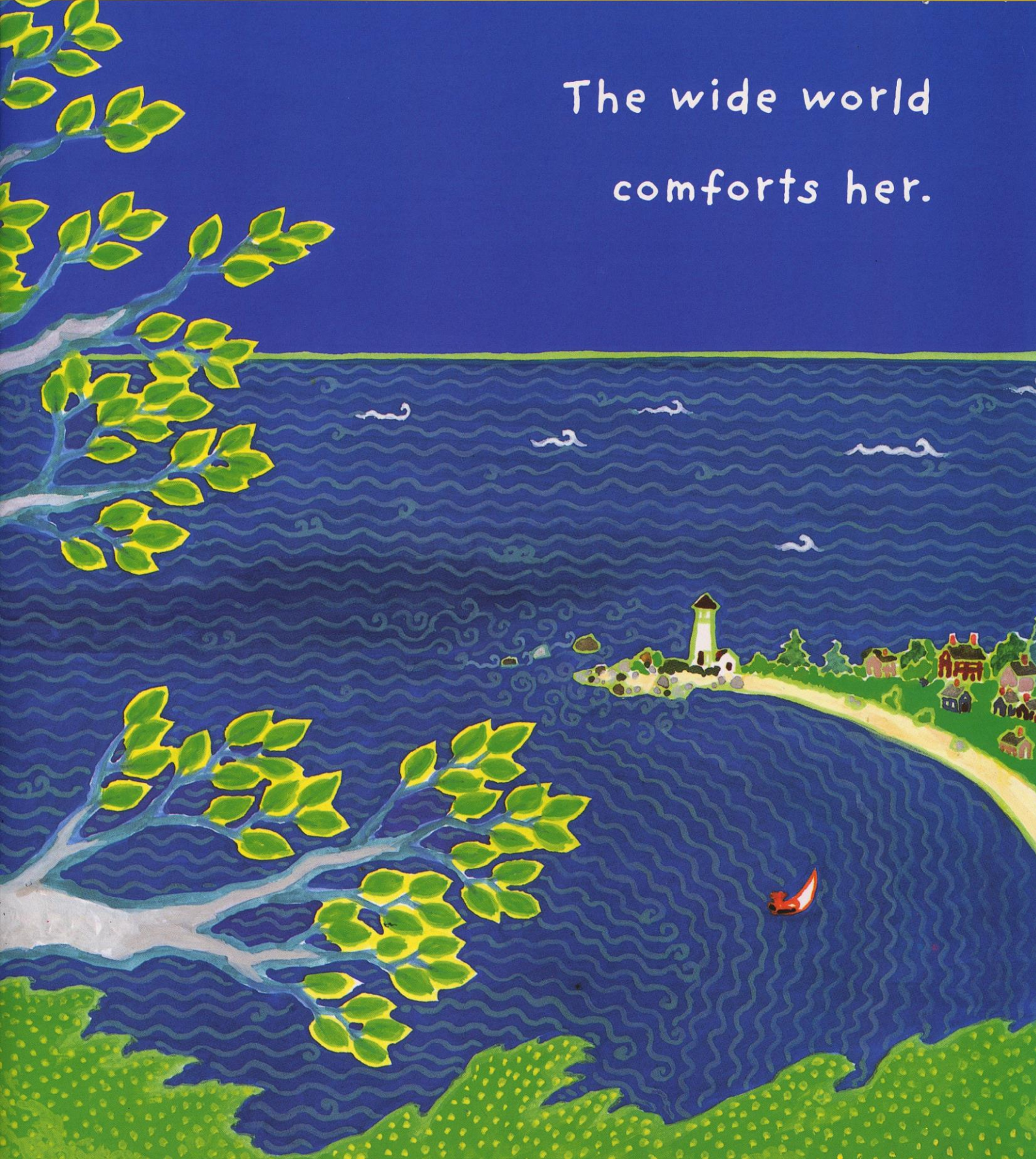




She feels the breeze

and the waves.



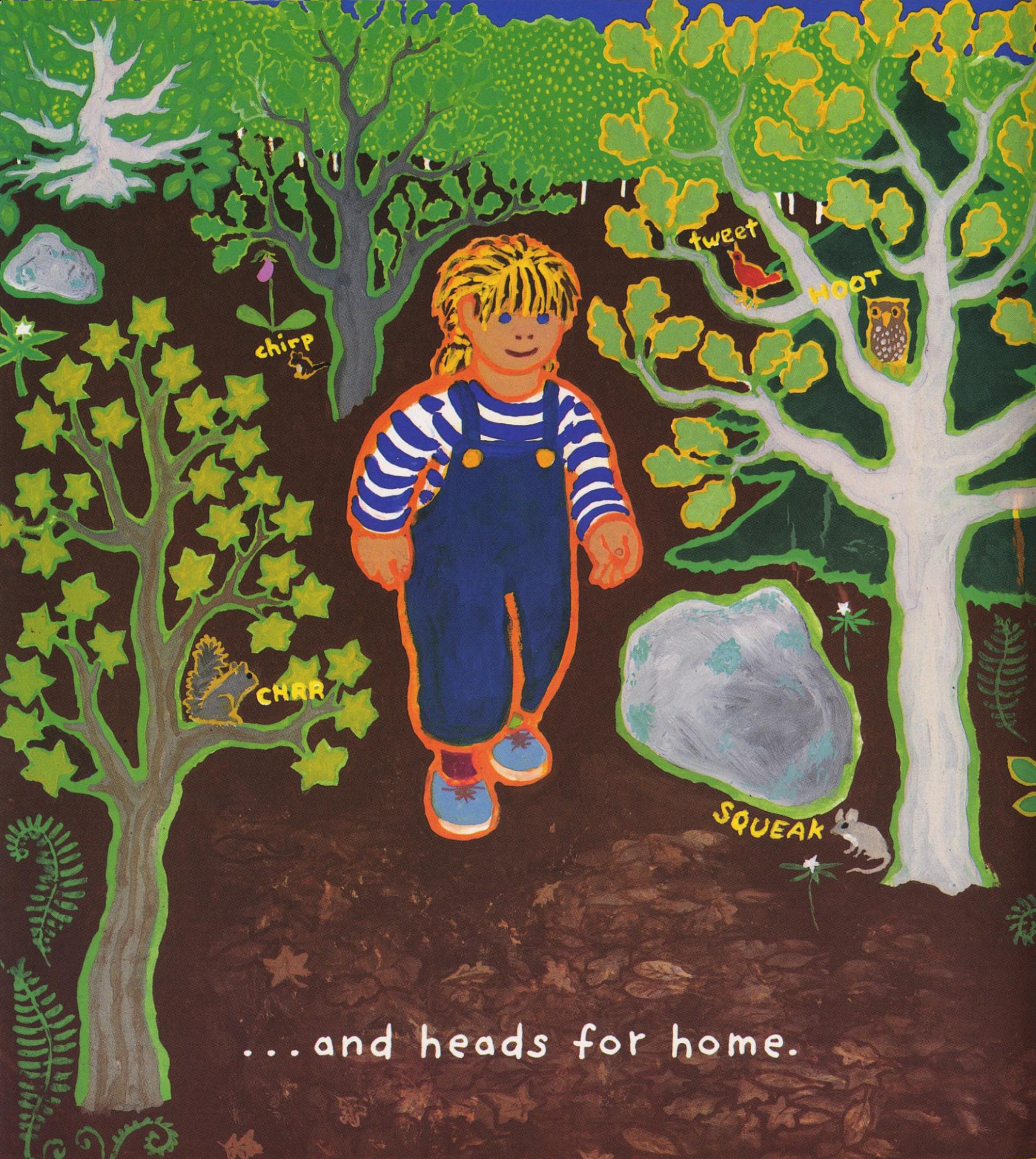
The wide world
comforts her.





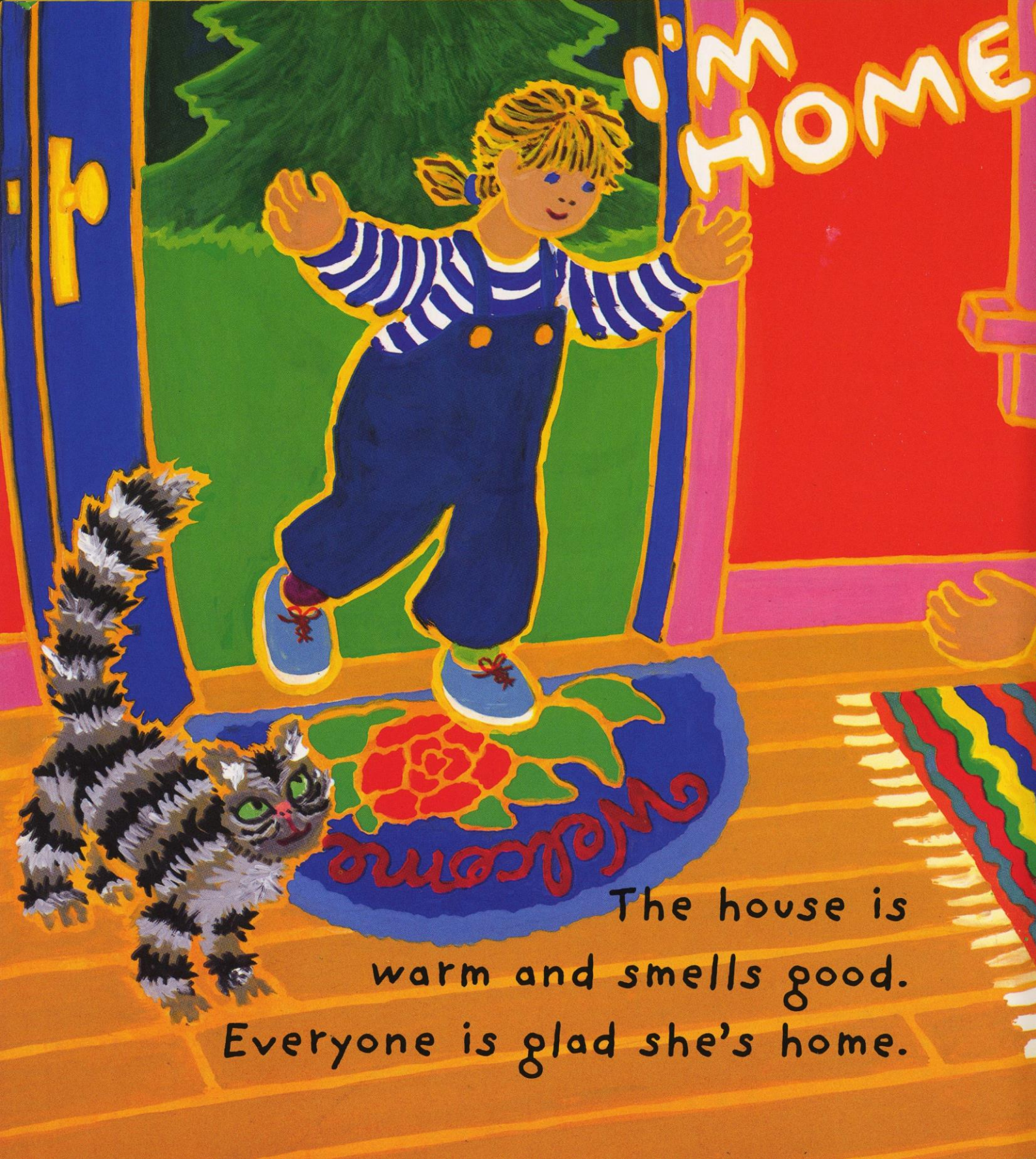
Sophie feels

Everyone is glad she's home.

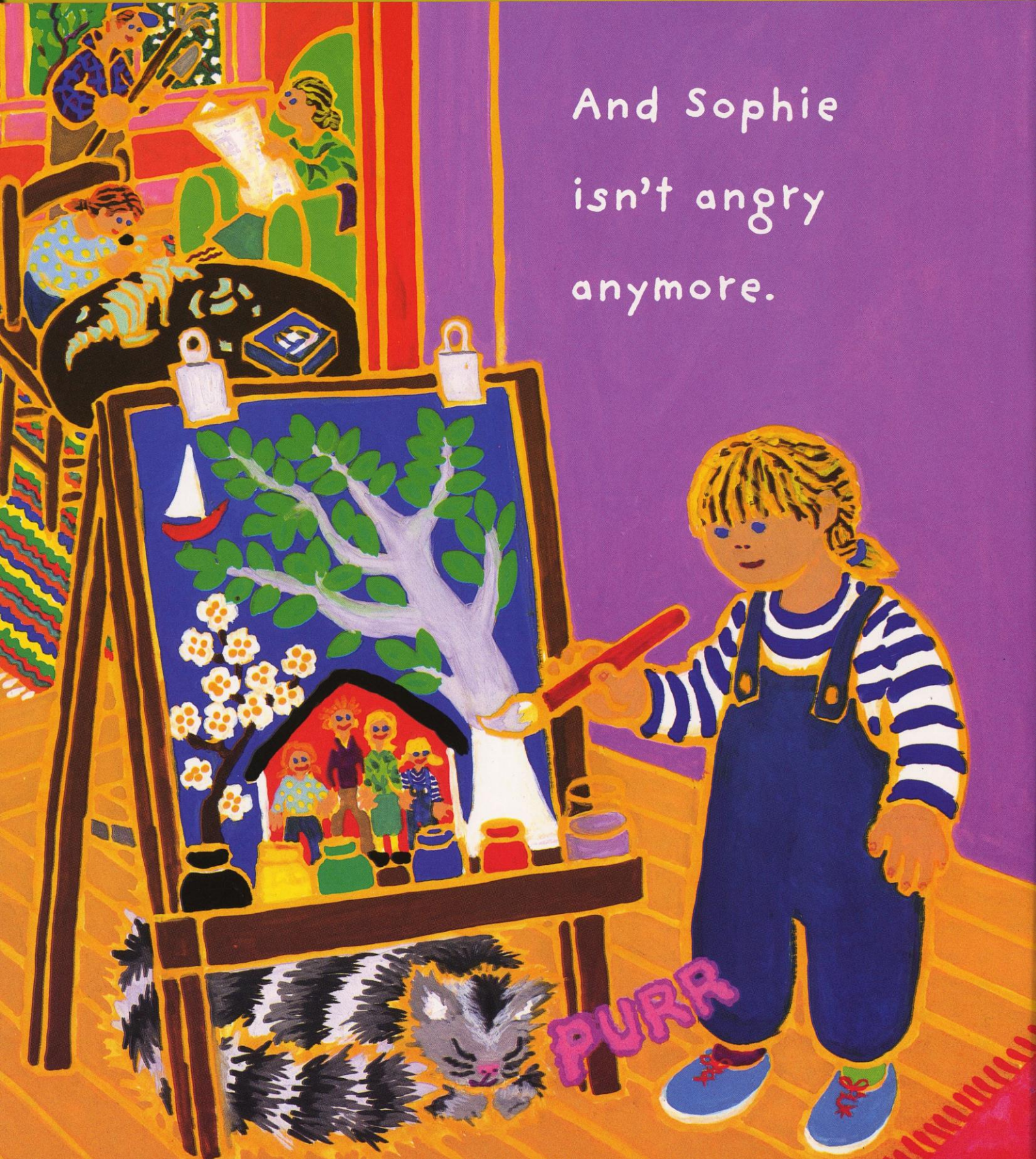

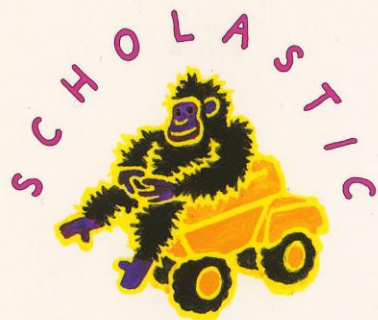
